## Say hello to Screen Two

The second screen will allow us to double the number of films we show as well as increasing the length of time we're able to show films for. It's also the new home for our relaxed screenings on Sunday mornings. Our relaxed screenings are intended to provide a safe environment for neurodiverse audiences, but are open to everyone. This screen will also be the permanent home of our 16mm analogue projector, making it the perfect space to screen artist films as part of our new **Pavilion Presents** strand.

Also screening lots of new releases, our new Screen Two is located in a new lower level with a cosy lobby area outside which

has additional seating that audiences are welcome to use whenever we are open. It's fully accessible via a new platform lift and the screen has space for two wheelchairs.

We're thrilled with how it's turned out and hope you love it as much as we do. Huge thanks to the project team for turning what was once an underused basement, into an amazing new screening space for everyone in Leeds to enjoy! Thanks also to everyone who's sponsored a seat in Screen Two. 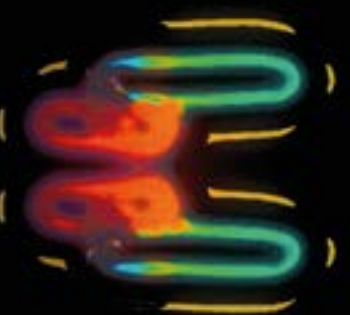
